 - Source Citation choose APA 7th copy and paste that at the bottom of your paper or on your notes pages
 - Example: David Brewster. (2006). In *World of Invention*. Gale. https://link.gale.com/apps/doc/K1647000057/SUIC?u=ak_sdlc_web&sid=bookmark-SUIC&xid=a8191fc7
- Biography Reference Center Type in your scientist Choose the detailed biography you want to use
 - You can save the article to your google drive if needed or you can print it so you have it for taking notes.
 -  Click on citation to cite and choose APA 7th edition copy and paste that on the bottom of your page
 - Example: Curie, Marie. (2012). *Britannica Biographies*, 1.
 - If you use more than one source cite each source on a Reference Page
