### Book:

Last, F. M. (Year Published). *Book title*. City, State: Publisher.

Example:

Twain, M. (1999). *The adventures of Tom Sawyer*. Irvine, CA: Saddleback Educational.

### Encyclopedia:

Last, F. M., & Last, F. M. (Year Published). Article title. In Encyclopedia Name. (Vol.#, pp. Page(s)). City, State: Publisher.

### Examples:

McGhee, K., & McKay, G. (2007). Insects. In Encyclopedia of Animals. (pp. 170-171). Washington, DC: National Geographic Society.

### Website:

Last, F. M. (Year, Month Date Published). Article Title. *Website Title*. from URL

### Example:

Satalkar, B. (2010, July 15). Water aerobics. *Buzzle.com*. from <http://www.buzzle.com>

Website no Author

Title of the article. (year, Month day). News Organization. URL (no period after the URL)

### Journal:

Last, F. M., & Last, F. M. (Year Published). Article title. *Journal Name*, Volume(Issue), pp. Page(s).

### Example:

Jacoby, W. G. (1994). Public attitudes toward government spending. *American Journal of Political Science*, 38(2), 336-361.

**Format must be: Author Date Format : Double Spaced, Hanging Indent and Alphabetical Order**
